WHEREAS, The Town of Washington recognizes the threat that natural and technological hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions prior to the occurrence of disasters will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Washington participated jointly in the planning process with the other units of government within Green County to prepare and *All Hazard Mitigation Plan Revision* as an official plan;






